You may think it's too early, but orders for spring planting should be in to nurseries by end of January to ensure you get the varieties you want. That means starting your planting plan earlier than you think!

October - November Maple Care

- rake & dispose of leaves if foliar disease or mold was a problem during the growing season - this reduces the potential for re-infestation next year
- [replenish the mulch](#) ring around the base of the trees
- [prune](#) only lightly, if necessary, after the leaves have fallen
- monitor for the presence of voles, rabbits & deer
- install rodent and deer protection as needed
